Power of Attorney (POA) Guide Checklist

Use this to prepare your thoughts before drafting your General Power of Attorney. This is not your final POA - just a planning tool.

POA PREPARATION	Ensure you (the Donor) understand the authority being granted
	Confirm the Attorney (person you appoint) is trustworthy.
	Print the POA clearly on plain A4/Letter paper
SIGNING	You (the Donor) must sign in the presence of two witnesses OR a Notary Public/Commissioner for Oaths.
	Each witness must sign immediately after you.
	Witnesses must include their full names, addresses, and occupations.
	The Attorney's acceptance signature may be required depending on jurisdiction.
GHANA-SPECIFIC NOTES	The POA must be notarized or witnessed by a Commissioner for Oaths.
	For property transactions, the POA must be registered at the Lands Commission.

STORAGE	Keep the original POA safe.
(Give certified copies to your Attorney.
	Execution complete when signed and duly witnessed/notarized.
